

Post Falls Highway District held the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony for the recently completed Prairie Avenue & Chase Road Roundabout on Wednesday, October 3, 2018.



The Prairie Avenue – Chase Road Roundabout was an intersection improvement project primarily funded through a Local Strategic Initiatives (LSI) grant administered by the Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC).

The Prairie Avenue-Chase Roundabout qualified for \$1 Million in funding due to the safety improvements provided by the roundabout along with the positive impacts the project has to commerce and mobility. The amount of crashes and crash severity should decline while still providing free flowing mobility to all traffic, including to the Kootenai County Solid Waste Transfer Station located west of this project. With the future growth projections for the City of Post Falls being 24.7 % of the county by 2020, an free flowing intersection improvement now is forward thinking.
