GENERAL PROVISIONS

The Highway District may revoke, annul, change, amend, amplify, or terminate this permit or any of the conditions herein enumerated if Grantee fails to comply with any or all of its provisions, requirements, or regulations as herein set forth or if Grantee fails to heed or comply with notices given.

In accepting this permit, the Grantee, his successors and assigns agree to be responsible for any damage or injury done to the property of the Grantee.

Neither the acceptance of this permit or anything herein contained shall be construed as a waiver by the Grantee of any rights given it by the Constitution or laws of the State of Idaho or the United States.

In accepting this permit, the Grantee, its successors and assigns agree to protect the Highway District, or its agents, and save it harmless from all claims, actions, or damages of every kind and description which may accrue to or be suffered by any person or persons, corporation or property, and in case any suit or action is brought against said Highway District, its officers, or agents, for damages arising out of or by reason of any of the above causes, the Grantee, its successors or assigns will upon notice to it of commencement of such action, defend the same at its own sole cost and expense, and will satisfy any judgement after said suit or action shall have finally been determined if adverse to the Highway District, its officers or agents.

Except as herein authorized, no vehicle shall be moved within the limits of the highway in such a manner to interfere with the travel over said road.

This permit does not constitute a vested right, but rather a privilege, which may be revoked at any time by said Highway District.
